Slide #10: Connections (to a character, to an event, to a feeling)

Slide #11: Questions: what questions do you have now that the book is over?

Slide #12: Visualize: Pick a passage from the book that allowed you to have strong visualizations

Project #2: Epilogue

Using your understanding of the characters, plot and setting, write the next chapter of the novel.

Criteria:

- > 5-8 pages minimum in length
- > Illustrations similar to the novel
- ➤ Similar writing style of Sandy Frances Duncan (vocabulary, sentence fluency, etc.)
- ➤ Includes information that shows understanding of the story elements

Project #3: Picture Book

Using your understanding of the characters, plot and setting, create a primary story version of Cariboo Runaway.
